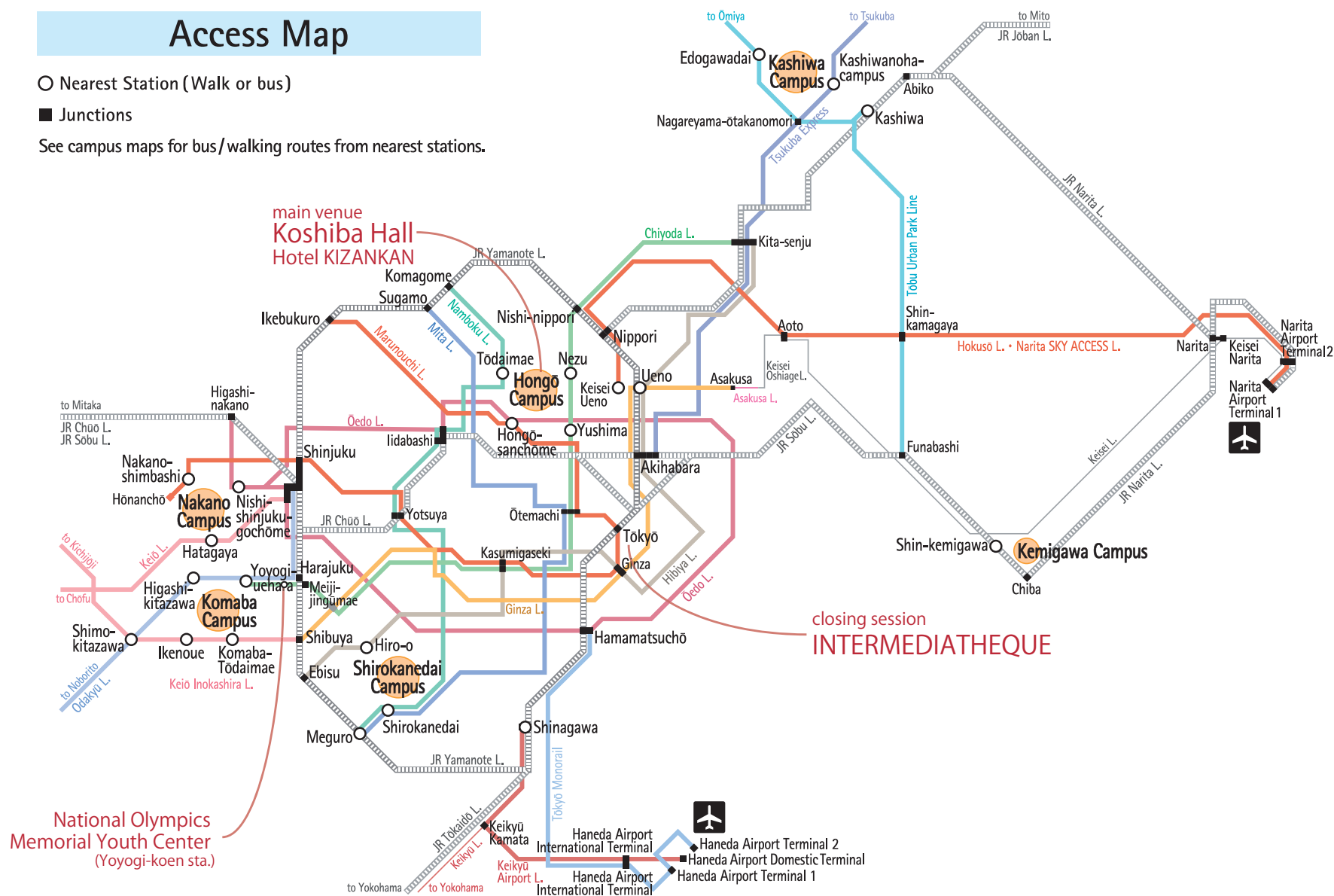


Access Map

How to get to the conference venue (Koshiba Hall) / Hotel KIZANKAN

Koshiba Hall (Faculty of Science, Building 1)

The nearest metro stations:

- Hongo-sanchome (M22, Marunouchi metro line / E08, Oedo line) for Koshiba Hall / Hotel KIZANKAN
- Todaimae (N12, Namboku metro line) for Koshiba Hall
- Nezu (C14, Chiyoda metro line) for Koshiba Hall

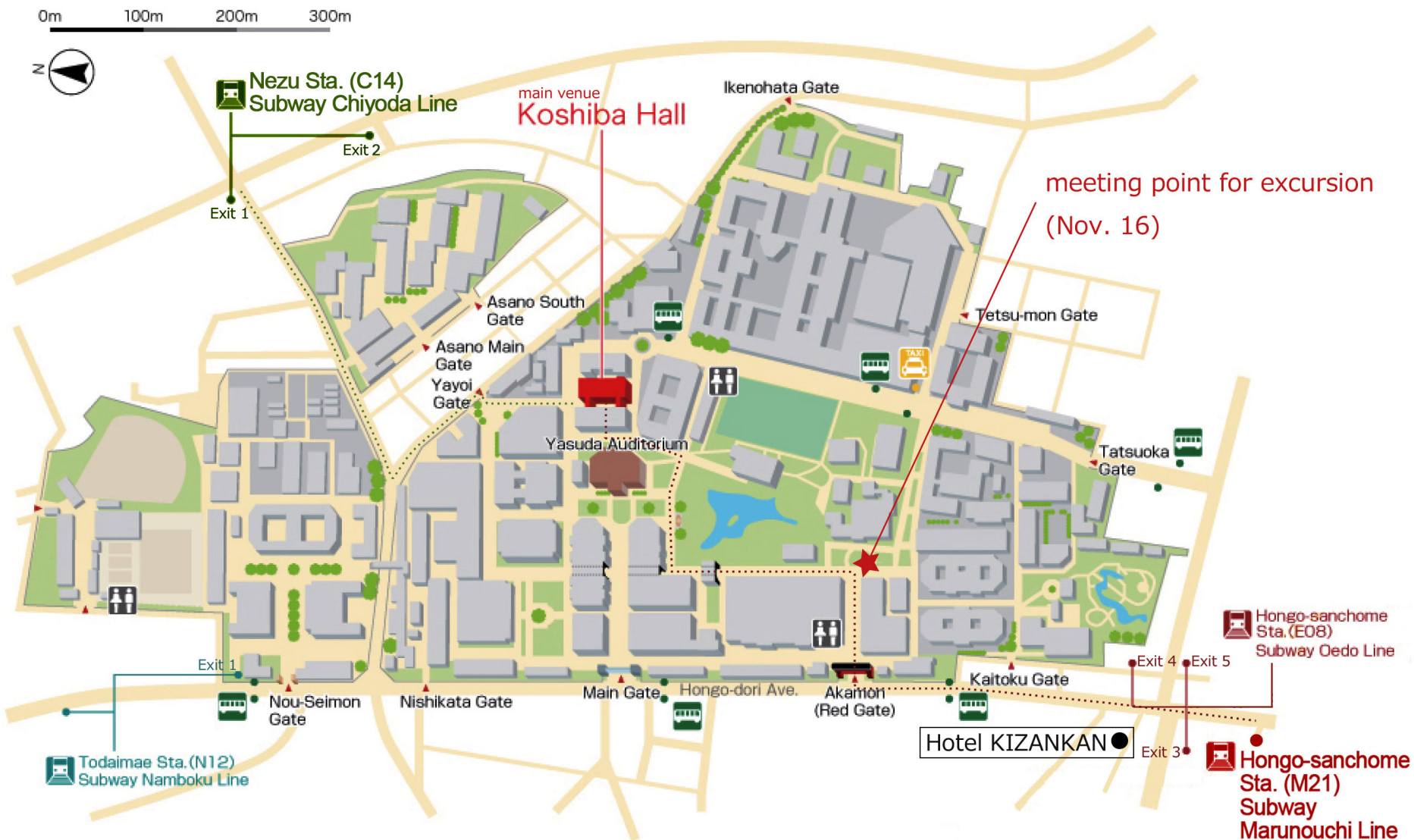
Access from Narita Airport (60 km away):

1. Train & taxi:
Take the Keisei Skyliner train to Keisei-Ueno station (2,400 JPY) and get a taxi to the hotel/Koshiba Hall (about 1,500 yen).
2. Train & metro (subway):
Take the JR Narita Express train to Tokyo station (3,000 JPY) and change for Marunouchi metro line (bound for Ikebukuro) to Hongo-sanchome station.
3. Airport bus & metro (subway):
Take an airport bus to Tokyo station (1,000~2,800 JPY) and change for Marunouchi metro line (bound for Ikebukuro) to Hongo-sanchome station.

Access from Haneda Airport (20 km away):

1. Monorail, JR train & metro (subway):
Take the Tokyo Monorail to Hamamatsucho station, change for the JR Yamanote line train to Tokyo station and change for Marunouchi metro line (bound for Ikebukuro) to Hongo-sanchome station.
2. Keikyu train, JR train & metro (subway)
Take the Keikyu line train to Shinagawa station, change for the JR Yamanote line train to Tokyo station and change for Marunouchi metro line (bound for Ikebukuro) to Hongo-sanchome station.

* Notice for travel on Sunday 16, November: the JR Yamanote line (between Osaki-Tokyo-Ueno stations) and JR Keihin-Tohoku line (between Shinagawa-Tamachi) will be suspended due to planed engineering work.

Travel from the Koshiba Hall to the IMT (Friday 15, afternoon)

Take Marunouchi metro line from Hongo-sanchome station to Tokyo station. Take the south exit to the underground passage directly connected to the entrance of the KITTE. The entrance of the IMT is located on the second floor.
